Sewer Rate Increase for 2nd Quarter of 2026

The Village will be increasing the quarterly sewer bills again. The cost of the waste water relocation project is something that needs to happen per the DNR and needs to be completed by March of 2028 to be compliance. The board does not have an option but to increase the rate. The reality of the sewer rates will continue to increase several more times. Rates are as follows:

Single \$174 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee
Duplex \$348 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee
Triplex \$522 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee
4 Plex \$696 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee
Multiple (24 units) \$4,176 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee

Commercial \$696 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee
Taverns \$696 Quarterly plus \$10 stormwater fee

Just wanting to remind folks that this project has been in the works for several years and has been on the boards radar since 2012.

All ATV/UTV drivers please watch your speed, the village ordinance §376-4 indicates operators shall not exceed 25mph, when approaching folks walking on the roadways -PLEASE SLOW DOWN! Make sure you have your lights on. Helmets are required for everyone under the age of 18. No person may operate a ATV / UTV on Village roadways unless the owner or operator has a liability insurance (this is the law) in your possession at all times.

Did you know? Regular ditch cleaning is essential to prevent flooding, control erosion, protect ecosystems, and reduce pest problems.

Clean ditches support healthy ecosystems. Please don't use weed killer in your ditch as animals and kids could be playing in them after a heavy rain.

One primary reason to have a clean ditch is to help prevent flooding. One reason why flooding occurs this time of year is the snow is packed in ditches and culverts are full of debris and sediment.

When ditches are neglected and left to fill with debris, silt, and overgrown vegetation their ability to function as a effective water channel diminishes. Neglected ditches can lead to a host of problems such as soil erosions, foundation issues, landscape damage and flooding and water infiltration. Floodwater can infiltrate basements and lower levels of buildings, causing extensive water damage and costly repairs.
